
















1876 – 1909 HISTORIC BEGINNINGS

Fairmont Copley Plaza was built on the original site of the Museum of Fine Arts, which was in Copley Square from 1876 until 1909 when the museum moved into its existing building on Huntington Avenue. Dozens of horse-drawn carts took the museum's collection of thousands of pieces of art approximately one mile down the street to the new museum.



1910

The "E" shaped building is a city block large and strongly supported by wooden pilings driven to the depth of 70 feet below street level.

It took 16 months and \$5.5 million to build
The Copley Plaza. Laborers earned 35 cents an hour, working
7 days a week. Because the site was a former wetland, workers
drove 8,000 pilings to a depth of 70 feet.



1912 GRAND OPENING

Long regarded as a Boston institution, The Copley Plaza was formally opened on August 8, 1912, about 16 months after construction of the building began. Mayor of Boston John F. "Honey Fitz" Fitzgerald, President Kennedy's grandfather, presided over a reception for more than 1,000 guests, including local and national dignitaries, civic leaders, captains of industry, and stage and movie stars.

So prestigious was The Copley Plaza's opening that rooms had been booked 16 months in advance.



1930s

During Prohibition, our current restaurant space was known as the Merry-Go-Round Bar, a lively gathering place. Patrons celebrated the end of Prohibition in 1933 at The Copley Plaza's famous Merry-Go-Round Bar, which featured a working merry-go-round. It remained a popular gathering place through the 1970s. Pieces of the carousel Track have been preserved in the floor of OAK Long Bar + Kitchen.

The Oval Room was the scene of the popular tea dances as well as being "the" place to be for special events. While painting his murals at the Boston Public Library, John Singer Sargent, and his patron Isabella Stewart Gardner, would be seen lunching in the Oval Room. There was a skating rink in the Oval Room under the dance floor where Rudy Valle sang in the 1930s.



INDUSTRY FIRSTS

The Fairmont Copley Plaza is also recognized as an innovator in the hotel industry. The hotel is known for these industry firsts: the first completely air-conditioned hotel in Boston, the first hotel with an international reservations system, the first hotel anywhere to accept credit cards, and the first to offer direct telephone dialing for guests.



BETWEEN 1939 - 1945

During World War II, the hotel's elevator "boys" had to be over 65, so younger men were free for military service.






Regular guests have included Richard Burton and Elizabeth Taylor. The first visit they made to the Copley Plaza was in 1964, following their first wedding, and they made quite an entrance with a throng of 1,000 admirers greeting them in the hotel.





1967 KENSINGTON LIONS

For more than 50 years, two gilded lions have guarded the St. James entrance to the hotel. Sculpted by Alexander Pope, the lions were originally carved for the entrance to the Kensington Hotel. When that hotel was demolished in 1967, the lions were "rescued" by The Copley Plaza.









2 BEACON HILL

Beacon Hill, is one of Boston's oldest neighborhoods, filled with charming, narrow cobblestone streets, federal style row houses and gaslit streetlamps. It's great to walk on Charles Street for a unique boutique shopping experience. Source: www.landscapes.northeastern.edu

3 FRANKLIN PARK ZOO

For animal adventures, pay a visit to the Franklin Park Zoo. The 72-acre zoo is the place to be for a red panda, tiger, or zebra sighting right in the middle of the city. There are also plenty of expert-led chats to attend, as well as children's events, making it a place the entire family will love.

4 BOSTON SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA

Fairmont Copley Plaza is the Official Hotel of the Boston Symphony Orchestra and Boston Pops. Led by Music Director Andris Nelsons since 2014, the Boston Symphony Orchestra gave its inaugural concert in 1881. Today the BSO reaches millions of listeners through their concert performances.





5 WALK AROUND THE ESPLANADE

Another worthy place for a stroll is the Esplanade, a three-mile path that hugs the Charles River. It's an excellent spot for a walk or bike ride along the lovely green spaces on the banks of the river, where you can watch boaters.

9 BOSTON PUBLIC LIBRARY







With Joe Fallon Les Clefs d'Or Concierge at Fairmont Copley Plaza

WHEN DID YOU DECIDE TO BECOME A CONCIERGE AND HOW DID YOU START?

I fell into the hotel industry by accident! I worked as a bartender in Copley Square and genuinely enjoyed meeting new people and giving visitors my tried-and-true Boston recommendations. I grew up here and know the city like the back of my hand. My friends called me their "bar concierge," so when an official concierge position opened nearby at this hotel I was encouraged to apply. It was a natural transition, and I loved it from the moment I started.

WHAT DOES YOUR JOB ENTAIL AND CAN YOU DESCRIBE A NORMAL DAY?

Every day brings new opportunities and creative challenges - I come to work never knowing what will happen, so it's important to be prepared for all requests. I speak with guests about their trip plans, greet arrivals in the lobby, make restaurant reservations, schedule tours and arrange tickets for Boston attractions. One minute I could be reserving a private plane for a guest to jet to Cape Cod, and the next hiring a personal trainer for a same-day session.

TELL US ABOUT THE HOTEL'S UNIOUE CANINE AMBASSADOR PROGRAM.

Our hotel is world-renowned for being pet-friendly through our Canine Ambassador program, which started in 2004 with the adoption of our first black Lab, Catie Copley. The purpose is to provide companionship to travelers who may be missing their animals at home. Her lobby dog duties made her famous and inspired two children's books. Our current ambassador, Cori Copley, is my best friend and I always tell people that I work for her! People can follow her hotel adventures on Instagram: @coricopley.

WHAT IS THE ADVANTAGE OF SPEAKING TO A CONCIERGE?

The biggest advantage is the personal connections that concierges have; many of my relationships in the city date back 10 or 15 years so my advice is all rooted in trust. Guests can trust that I will book them the most reliable car driver, for example. Also, concierge teams still have unprecedented access to tickets. Fairmont Copley Plaza is the Official Hotel of the Boston Symphony Orchestra, and I have an "in" to book the best seats in the house for our guests.

WHAT DO YOU ENJOY THE MOST ABOUT BEING A CONCIERGE?

My favorite part of the job is seeing repeat guests, especially kids I met years ago who are now adults. The key to hotel success is when people keep coming back for our hospitality, and it is a joy to be in touch with the same visitors over the years. Also, as a concierge stationed front-and-center in the lobby, I have the perfect view when exciting social events take place. WHAT PLACES DO YOU GENERALLY RECOMMEND?

For first-time visitors, I always recommend walking around the North End - my favorite place in the entire city because of the delicious food and old-school Boston atmosphere. While there, stop by Café Paradiso for tiramisu and espresso martinis. Harpoon Brewery in the Seaport is a fun vibe on the water and they offer a phenomenal tour of their facilities. What's ideal about our central location is that guests can rent Blue Bikes right here in Copley Square, and bike to so many nearby places to take in the views and see the city's historical landmarks.






SYMPHONY HALL
